

# IOWA FARM BUREAU FEDERATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

In 2012 the Iowa Farm Bureau Federation will award **fifty-four** \$1,000 scholarship awards to students pursuing the completion of a two or four-year undergraduate degree. The **tuition** awards will be distributed in \$500 increments during fall 2012 and spring 2013 semesters. Six district winners will be selected in each of the nine Iowa Farm Bureau Federation districts. The districts are indicated below.

## Iowa Farm Bureau Districts



A Daniel Johnson Memorial scholarship award of \$500 will also be awarded to one student within District 7 who is pursuing an agricultural degree. The recipient will be selected from the IFBF scholarship applications submitted to IFBF by the District 7 counties. Eligibility requirements are the same as the IFBF scholarship award. *This \$500 scholarship award is for one year only, to be disbursed to the college/university prior to fall semester and is non-renewable.*

## ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

1. Sons and/or daughters of Iowa Farm Bureau members are eligible. Applicants must apply in the county where their Farm Bureau membership is held. **If membership is held in more than one county – application is to be submitted to just one county Farm Bureau office in the state of Iowa.**
2. Must be accepted by or enrolled in an accredited college, university or community college.
3. Must be a high school graduate, or if still in high school must have an expected graduation date of spring 2012.
4. College freshmen, sophomores or juniors in a two or four-year accredited college/university are also eligible to apply. Please include a **college** transcript with your grade point average with application.
5. **Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average throughout their college career and be pursuing a degree in agriculture to continue to qualify for the four-year renewable scholarship. Student must maintain at least a 12-hour workload and/or be considered a full time student paying full time tuition.**
6. Graduate students are not eligible for this scholarship.
7. Applicants must be working toward a degree in one of the following occupational areas of agriculture and/or agribusiness:
  - **Ag Health** – i.e. BSN or RN Nursing (plans to work in a rural community), Physical/Occupational Therapy (whose plan is to work directly with clients with *ag-related injuries*). ***This does not include the following fields: Medicine, General Pharmacy, Dentistry, Radiology, etc.***
  - **Ag Production** – i.e. Animal Science, Dairy Science, Equine Science, Veterinary Science including *Veterinary Pharmacy*
  - **Ag Products & Processing** – i.e. Food Science, Nutritional Sciences
  - **Ag Sales & Service** – i.e. Agricultural Business
  - **Agricultural Research** – i.e. Biofuels, Biorenewables, Genetics
  - **Conservation and Natural Resources** – i.e. Environmental Studies, Wildlife Ecology & Conservation
  - **Economics** – i.e. Agricultural Economics, Public Service & Administration in Agriculture, Global – International Agriculture Studies
  - **Education** – i.e. Ag Education & Studies and/or Elementary or Secondary teachers only
  - **Environmental Systems** - i.e. Wind Turbine Energy, Mechanical Engineering
  - **Forestry** – i.e. Natural Resources, Ecology, Forestry
  - **Horticulture** – i.e. Agronomy, Landscape Horticulture/Architecture
  - **Mechanization** – i.e. Agricultural Systems Technology, Agricultural Engineering
