We are in receipt of your annual survey, have reviewed your most recent accreditation documents, and have determined that Jones International University continues to meet the compliance requirements promulgated by Title 23, Article 2 for authorization to operate in Colorado. Thank you for taking the time to update your institution's information.

The Colorado Commission on Higher Education has statutory responsibility for administration of Title 23, Article 2 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, (amended 2008), which authorizes certain types of institutions to offer degrees or degree credits. Persons or organizations which violate the provisions of the statute are subject to legal penalties.

Department records show Jones International University is authorized by the Colorado Commission on Higher Education to offer postsecondary education and continues to hold accreditation by the Higher Learning Commission, a Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, a United States Department of Education recognized accreditation body.
